## about us

Marine Reach Fiji is an entirely voluntary organisation, relying on God's provision and calling to meet the medical needs of the people living in remote villages .

Fiji demonstrates a huge contrast between incredibly friendly, hospitable people living in a beautiful country and the poor quality of health that overshadows their lives. We offer primary healthcare, dental, optometry and physiotherapy services to those who cannot access medical care or afford the costs.

Our work is Christ-centred and includes prayer, worship and counselling in the locations we visit, so non-medical personnel are welcome.

## our facilities

Our base in Lautoka is a well-equipped residence that can accommodate up to 18 people, complete with cooking and washing facilities. We have access to a second residence for even larger teams.

We have been donated an extensive range of medical, dental and optometry equipment that allows us to provide essential care to the villages. This is transported on our rugged four wheel drive truck which can access all but the most isolated of locations on the mainland.

## our outreaches

Since 2002 we have treated more than 50,000 men, women and children, visiting more than 20 of Fiji's many islands . This has been achieved through the assistance of visiting volunteers from all over the world, giving their time and skills to help those in need.

Several times a year we run a two-week outreach to the more remote villages in Fiji. The people there are often unable or cannot afford to make the journey to the hospitals and clinics for treatment, so we bring care to them.

- 8 weeks of outreach when we put learning into practice medically and evangelically
